The selection process is in two steps. ESA will examine your application and will contact you for a first interview in English by one of their team. If ESA decides you are a solid candidate we will pass your file on to the company.

ESA will arrange company **interviews in Poland in February 2022**. The company makes the final choice. The program begins in April 2022 for those who need French lessons and late August 2022 for French speakers.
